Detailed Instructions:

- 0. Incorporate the changes from Assignments 4,5 and 7 into your thesis proposal.
- 1. Write the final sections of your proposal.
 - Complete the timeline section of your proposal.
 - Complete the required resources section of your proposal, if it is appropriate.
 - Complete the abstract, introduction and conclusion sections of your proposal.
- 2. MAKE SURE that your writing makes sense in the context of your other sections (background, related work and problem statement). You should avoid duplication of material from other sections. You should also ensure that material is incorporated into the appropriate section – background information should appear in the background section, etc. You should edit your entire submission at least once after writing it.
- 3. Your proposal should be no more than 15 pages including references. You may need to edit your document to reach this page limit.
- 4. You proposal will be evaluated as an overall document, as well as on the new material included in this section. It is also expected that changes previously suggested will be made (see point 0.).
